YUKON KENNEL CLUB -- CODE OF ETHICS

The Yukon Kennel Club is incorporated under the Societies Register, Government of Yukon; and is a recognized member of the national organization, the Canadian Kennel Club.

All Yukon Kennel Club members agree to abide by the constitution and by-laws of the Yukon Kennel Club and the Canadian Kennel Club, including any changes made forthcoming.

Membership in the Yukon Kennel Club must represent a commitment to upholding and promoting the highest standards of conduct in dealing with their dogs, other canine enthusiasts and the general public.

Each member of the Yukon Kennel Club is expected to observe the highest standards of sportsmanship and conduct themselves in such a manner as to reflect positively on the sport of dogs.

YKC members must refrain from knowingly making unfair or untrue statements about the dogs or practices of others.

When asked by a member of the public for information about the dogs in general, specific breeds, canine sports, etc, YKC members should strive to offer helpful assistance in the form of honest information. Rudeness to spectators, other competitors, novice dog owners at shows or other public venues is unnecessary and demonstrates a lack of respect for the sport.

A YKC member shall provide proper and humane care and attention for all animals in their care.

The Executive of the YKC shall have the power to suspend, expel or reprimand any member if, in the opinion of the executive, he or she has violated any or all of the following:

- a) The constitution of the Yukon Kennel Club
- b) The Code of Ethics of the Yukon Kennel Club
- c) The by-laws of the Canadian Kennel Club.
